1. HELP EMPLOYEES MANAGE THEIR INDIVIDUAL PRIVACY

Encourage employees to update their individual account privacy settings by visiting [Update Your Privacy Settings](https://staysafeonline.org) on staysafeonline.org.

2. HOST A LUNCH AND LEARN

Invite outside speakers to talk to employees about why privacy matters. Engage staff by asking them to consider how privacy and data security applies to the work they do on a daily basis, regardless of department. 3. CREATE A #PRIVACYAWARE CULTURE
